Satisfaction is bigger if we consider that Lisa comes from two consecutive second places at Tor, the race of his life. She recently declared: "For me, Tor des Géants is the queen of all race because it is not just a race. It is a wonderful way to learn to hate what you don't like in yourself but then find yourself and accept yourself".
